



## SCHOOL OF GRADUATE STUDIES DISTRICT LEADERSHIP GRANT

The VFCC School of Graduate Studies District Leadership Grant provides AG districts with the opportunity to offer district ministers the opportunity to earn a master's degree at a greatly reduced tuition rate. Online graduate programs in Christian Leadership or Theology will be made available for a district to form a cohort group of 10 - 15 pastors and church leaders. Participants will be classified as non-matriculating, part-time graduate students.

### ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS:

Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university with a minimum GPA of 2.75

**For Christian Leadership:** Minimum of 6 undergraduate or graduate credits in Bible/Theology (if less than 6 credits, the applicant must score 95 or higher on the Biblical & Theological Assessment provided by the college).

**For Theology:** Minimum of 12 undergraduate or graduate credits in Theology. (if less than 12 credits, the applicant must score 95 or higher on the Biblical & Theological Assessment provided by the college).

**TUITION:**  
\$1275.00/3 credit course

**DISTRICT LEADERSHIP GRANT**  
\$575.00/3cr course (first 2 courses)  
\$425.00/3cr course (all remaining courses)

In semesters where students are enrolled in 6 credits or more they are eligible to apply for Federal financial aid.
