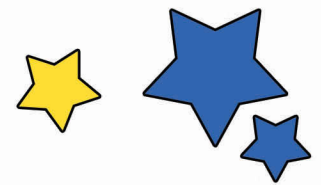

WHO MAY ATTEND?

All children currently enrolled in grades 1-6.

WHAT DOES IT COST?

Registration fees are \$103 per child (after Feb. 7, add \$20). Costs includes: 2 nights accommodations, 5 meals, and all breakaway events.

REGISTRATION

Please fill out Camper Application, along with the completed Medical Authorization, and return it to your church group leader. Please include the \$30 non-refundable deposit.

DEADLINES

Churches are encouraged to register by Feb. 7 (after Feb. 7, add \$20). Please make sure you allow enough time for your church to process your application.

ARRIVAL TIME

Registration will begin at 5:30 pm on Friday and the first service begins at 7:15 pm. Dinner will not be served that evening, so we encourage you to make sure your child has eaten prior to arrival.

DEPARTURE TIME

Sunday at 12:30 pm following the noon meal.

HOUSING

It is our desire to allow church groups to stay together during the retreat. Due to the design of the housing units, it may be necessary to house churches in multiple rooms and buildings. We may need to house your group with other groups and/or chaperones.

EXTRA MONEY

Those attending the retreat may want to bring extra money for the snack bar, bookstore, t-shirts, etc. In an effort to encourage missions, we will be collecting a one-time offering to support Home Mission churches.
