

COVID-19 Event Protocols







Medical Personnel • A nurse will be on site to oversee temperature screenings, COVID-19 questions and medical issues (applicable to large events).



Temperature Checks • All participants may be asked to submit to a touchless temperature check upon arrival at the event. Anyone with a temperature of 100.4 degrees or higher will be isolated for further medical evaluation.



Masks Required • In the spirit of cooperation with government authorities, masks will be required in all shared spaces when social distancing is not possible (indoors and outdoors). Children under 2 are exempt from wearing a mask.



Group Distancing • (When applicable) Participants are strongly encouraged to remain with the group they traveled to the event with. Each group should plan to stay together when possible for the duration of the event.



Altar-in-Place • The altar is located where you and your group are located. Remain in place with your group and pray together during altar and prayer times.



On-Site Food Service • (Where applicable) Participants should stay with their groups during meals. Groups should be seated to maintain distancing.



Sanitizer Stations • Hand sanitizer stations will be available throughout the event.

DAY OF EVENT - COVID-19 QUESTIONNAIRE

Each participant must complete this form within 24 hours prior to attending any PennDel Event.

An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present. COVID-19 is a contagious virus that can lead to severe illness and death. According to the <u>Centers for Disease Control and Prevention</u>, senior citizens and those with underlying medical conditions are especially vulnerable. By attending PennDel Ministry Network events, I voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to COVID-19 and hold harmless the PennDel Ministry Network from all liability related thereto. I understand that some activities may not follow traditional social distancing.

Each participant will be asked to submit to a touch-less temperature check upon arrival at the event. Anyone with a temperature 100.4 degrees or higher will be isolated for further medical evaluation. I understand that if I develop symptoms of COVID-19 while at the event, I may be sent to a testing site to be checked for COVID-19, and I also understand that I may be asked to leave the event prior to receiving COVID-19 test results.

I understand that if I answer YES to the following TWO questions, I will not attend the event in person.

1. Have you tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 14 days?

2. Have you knowingly had contact with anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 14 days?

I understand that if I answer YES to question THREE, I would have been required to be have been seen by a medical professional and been diagnosed with something other than COVID-19 to attend a PennDel event. PennDel reserves the right to prohibit your entrance to a PennDel event.

3. Have you had a combination of these NEW symptoms in the past 14 days?

- Fever of 100.4 or higher (without fever reducing medication)
- Feeling feverish (chills, sweating)
- New cough
- Difficulty breathing
- Sore throat
- Muscle aches or body aches
- Vomiting or diarrhea
- New loss of taste or smell

According to the <u>Centers for Disease Control and Prevention</u>, some PennDel Ministry Network events are categorized at the highest risk level, because individuals from various geographical areas may mix between groups and may not always remain spaced apart.
